
Camp Choconut is located on a pristine, private lake in Pennsylvania's Blue Ridge Mountains 17 miles south of Binghamton, New York. 180 miles from Philadelphia, New York City, and Buffalo, Camp Choconut's climate features smog-free mountain air, warm days and cool nights. The rustic camp buildings are built of materials found in the area. The sleeping cabins are of wood and Alumni End, the 70+-year-old lodge, is of stone.

You will be provided rustic lodging in cabins with electric lights. Modern bathrooms and shower facilities are in a separate building nearby. Some cabins are just the right size for a single family, others large enough to accommodate as many as three or four families.

We have a modern dining hall, a restaurant-grade kitchen, and a beautiful stone lodge.

Adults are expected to participate by volunteering for duties and activities. You may decide to help serve lunch one day, help build a bonfire the next day, and referee a pick-up game of soccer on the third. You may have a talent you want to share with the group, or you may wish to volunteer to help with something you have never tried before.

We anticipate your participation, but we don't make it onerous, and we hope to encourage your children to help.
